SSC CGL Tier I Exam Syllabus 2025

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SSC CGL Tier II Exam Syllabus 2025

The SSC CGL Tier II Exam is considered as the most-important part of the SSC CGL Selection Process 2025. It is the main exam and is crucial for the final selection of the eligible candidates. Candidates who clear the SSC CGL Tier I Exam 2025 will be eligible to attend the SSC CGL Tier II Exam 2025.

This SSC CGL Tier II Exam 2025 consists of two papers.

Paper I: Section I - Mathematical Abilities, Reasoning & General Intelligence, Section – II - English Language & Comprehension, General Awareness, Section III - Computer Knowledge Test

Paper II: Statistics

The SSC CGL Tier II Exam will be an objective test consisting of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs). Questions in Mathematical Abilities subject will be of Matriculation level. The questions in the English Language and Comprehension subject will be of 10+2 Level and the questions in Statistics will be of Graduation Level.

Paper I of the SSC CGL Tier II Exam 2025 will be compulsory for all posts.

Paper II of the SSC CGL Tier II Exam 2025 will be only for candidates who have applied for the posts of Junior Statistical Officer (JSO) in the Union Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation and Statistical Investigator Grade II in the office of Registrar General of India under the Union Ministry of Home Affairs.

It will be mandatory for all candidates to qualify all the sections of Paper I separately.

There will be a negative marking of 1 mark for each wrong answer in Section I, Section II and Section III of Paper I of the SSC CGL Tier II Exam 2025. A negative marking of 0.50 marks for each wrong answer in Paper II of the SSC CGL Tier II Exam 2025.

Section III of the Paper I, Computer Knowledge Test, is mandatory but qualifying in nature.

Paper II and Paper III of the SSC CGL Tier II Exam 2025 are conducted for candidates applying for the posts of Junior Statistical Officer and Assistant Audit Officer/ Assistant Accounts Officer respectively. Candidates can go through the complete SSC CGL topic wise Syllabus for Tier 2 for various SSC CGL Subjects.

CGL Tier II Syllabus: Mathematical Abilities

The CGL Tier II Syllabus for Mathematical Abilities section will consist of 30 questions for a total of 90 marks. Although this is similar to the Mathematical abilities section in Tier I syllabus, it is slightly tougher in comparison to the Maths Tier 2 CGL syllabus.

The following are the important topics of the SSC CGL Maths Tier II Syllabus:

Number Systems: Computation of Whole Number, Decimal and fractions, Relationship between numbers

Fundamental Arithmetic Operations: Percentages, Ratio and Proportion, Square Roots, Averages, Interest (Simple & Compound), Profit and Loss, Discount, Partnership Business, Mixture & Alligation, Time and Distance, Time and Work

Algebra: Basic algebraic identities of school algebra and elementary surds (simple problems) and Graphs of linear equations

Geometry: Familiarity with elementary geometric figures and facts – Triangles and its various kinds of centres, Congruence and similarity of triangles, Circle and its chords, tangents, angles subtended by chords of a circle, Common tangents to two or more circles

Mensuration: Triangle, Quadrilaterals, Regular Polygons, Circle, Right prism, Right circular cone, Right circular cylinder, Sphere, Hemispheres, Rectangular Parallelepiped, Regular right pyramid with triangular or square base

Trigonometry: trigonometry, Trigonometric ratios, Complementary angles, Height and distances (simple problems only), Standard identities like $\sin^2\theta + \cos^2\theta = 1$, etc.

Statistics and Probability: Use of tables and graphs: Histogram, Frequency polygon, Bar-diagram, Pie chart, Measures of Central Tendency: Mean, Median, Standard Deviation, Calculation of simple probabilities

The CGL Tier II Syllabus for Reasoning and General Intelligence section will consist of 30 questions for a total of 90 marks. Questions in this Tier II Reasoning and General Intelligence section will be of both verbal and non-verbal types. The topics in this section include the following:

CGL Tier II Syllabus: Computer Knowledge Test

The CGL Tier II Syllabus for Computer Knowledge Test section will consist of 20 questions for a total of 60 marks. It will be conducted for a duration of 15 minutes.

Computer Basics: Organisation of a computer, Central Processing Unit (CPU), Input /Output devices, Computer memory, Memory organisation, Back up devices, PORTs, Windows Explorer, Keyboard shortcuts

Software: Windows Operating system including basics of Microsoft Office like MS word, MS Excel and Power Point, etc.

Working with Internet and E-mails: Web Browsing and Searching, Downloading and Uploading, Managing an E-mail Account, e-Banking

Basics of Networking and Cyber Security: Networking devices and protocols, Network and information security threats (like hacking, virus, worms, Trojan, etc.) and preventive measures



CGL Tier II Syllabus: Statistics

This CGL Tier II Syllabus for Statistics section consist of 100 questions for a total of 200 marks. It will be conducted for a duration of 2 hours. This Statistics section will be only for candidates who have applied for the posts of JSO in the Union Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation and Statistical Investigator Grade II in the office of Registrar General of India under the Ministry of Home Affairs.

Collection, Classification and Presentation of Statistical Data: Primary and Secondary data, Methods of data collection; Tabulation of data; Graphs and charts; Frequency distributions; Diagrammatic presentation of frequency distributions

Measures of Central Tendency: Common measures of central tendency – mean median and mode; Partition values - quartiles, deciles, percentiles

Measures of Dispersion: Common measures dispersion – range, quartile deviations, mean deviation and standard deviation; Measures of relative dispersion

Moments, Skewness and Kurtosis: Different types of moments and their relationship; meaning of skewness and kurtosis; different measures of skewness and kurtosis

Correlation and Regression: Scatter diagram; simple correlation coefficient; simple regression lines; Spearman's rank correlation; Measures of association of attributes; Multiple regression; Multiple and partial correlation (For three variables only)

Probability Theory: Meaning of probability; Different definitions of probability; Conditional probability; Compound probability; Independent events; Bayes' Theorem

Random Variable and Probability Distributions: Random variable; Probability functions; Expectation and Variance of a random variable; Higher moments of a random variable; Binomial, Poisson, Normal and Exponential distributions; Joint distribution of two random variable (discrete)

Sampling Theory: Concept of population and sample; Parameter and statistic, Sampling and non-sampling errors; Probability and non-probability sampling techniques (simple random sampling, stratified sampling, multistage sampling, multiphase sampling, cluster sampling, systematic sampling, purposive sampling, convenience sampling and quota sampling); Sampling distribution (statement only); Sample size decisions

Statistical Inference: Point estimation and interval estimation, Properties of a good estimator, Methods of estimation (Moments method, Maximum likelihood method, Least squares method), Testing of hypothesis, Basic concept of testing, Small sample and large sample tests, Tests based on Z, t, Chi-square and F statistic, Confidence intervals

Analysis of Variance: Analysis of one-way classified data and two-way classified data

Time Series Analysis: Components of time series, Determinations of trend component by different methods, Measurement of seasonal variation by different methods

Index Numbers: Meaning of Index Numbers, Problems in the construction of index numbers, Types of index number, Different formulae, Base shifting and splicing of index numbers, Cost of living Index Numbers, Uses of Index Numbers

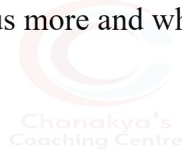
